The Child Protection Officer has the main responsibility for managing child and vulnerable adult protection issues within Bristol Taekwondo School. The role and responsibilities of the Child Protection Officer are detailed below. Specific responsibilities in relation to allegations against members are detailed in the Procedure for Managing Suspicions and Allegations of Abuse of a Child or Vulnerable Adult against Members Child Protection Policy

Key Functions:

Ensure there are policies, procedures, systems, structures, resources and personnel in place to promote the welfare and protection of children **at Bristol Taekwondo School.**

Work jointly with parents/carers and other agencies through joint planning, training and monitoring of their arrangements for the protection of children.

Ensure there are quality assurance mechanisms in place to monitor, review and evaluate arrangements for the protection of children.
